It's been a very good YEAR!

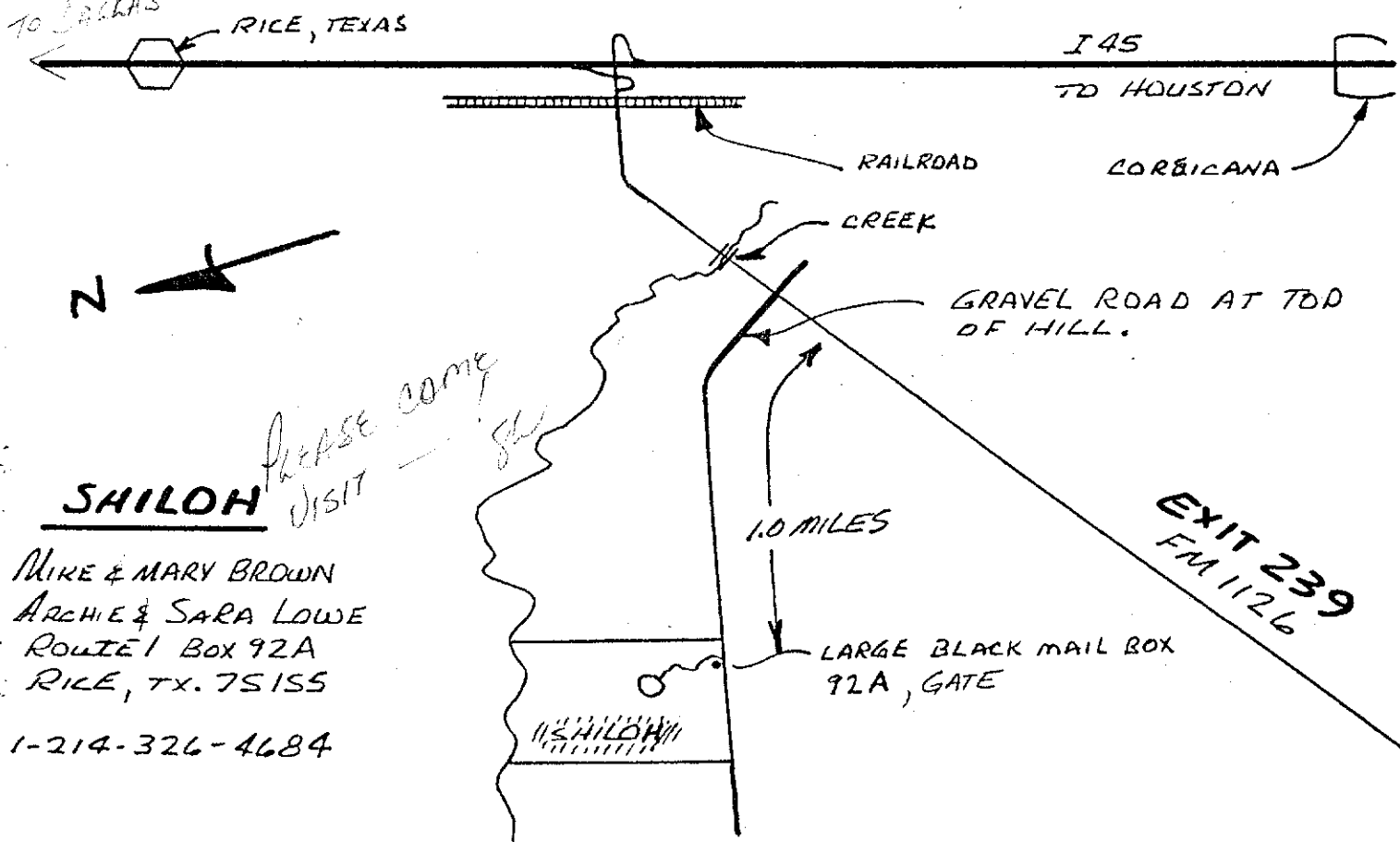
May our Father richly bless your work both physically and spiritually. Greet John for us all and exhort Him to search the Word daily for the eternal life promised to the faithful.
